- Enamel: The hard outer layer.
- **Dentin:** The outer covering of the teeth that is harder than the inner layer of the tooth.
- **Pulp:** The inner richly vascularized and innervated connective tissue core of the tumour.

If the pulp is diseased or inflamed, due to deep decay, a crack in the tooth, or an injury, it will also be very painful. **Root Canal**

<u>Treatment Preston</u> entails the removal of infected pulp, cleaning of the root canals and lastly filling to afford the tooth area no chance to get infected again.

- **1.Anesthesia:** Your dentist may then anesthetize the area surrounding the particular tooth that is involved with local anaesthesia.
- **2.Access to the Pulp:** A minor hole is made on the tooth to get in to the affected pulp chamber.
- **3.Removal of the Pulp:** This infected pulp is then very delicately eradicated from the root canals.

- **4.Cleaning and Shaping:** The root canals are therefore washed and downsized to allow for a filling process to take place.
- **5.Filling and Sealing:** The canals are then crammed with a substance that is biocompatible and the access cavity in the tooth is covered with a temporary filling.
- **6.Restoration:** In most cases, the tooth that has been treated is crowned to protect it as well as build up its strength in order to function as it should.
